

JOHANNEBERG SCIENCE PARK

Johanneberg Science Park is a collaborative arena for urban development, where innovations are co-generated for a society that is good for people and the environment. The science park brings together academia, society and a variety of large and small companies. Together they run national and international innovation projects and test solutions for future challenges.

One of the projects Johanneberg Science Park coordinates, on behalf of the City of Gothenburg, is the EU collaboration IRIS Smart Cities. The project involves seven European cities and focuses on new solutions within the areas of energy, mobility and ICT (Information and Communication Technology).

In Gothenburg the IRIS-project and its nine local partners are testing several innovative solutions found in the buildings around Johanneberg Science Park – HSB Living Lab, Riksbyggen Brf Viva and A Working Lab.
